Rules for the Exhibition:

- 1. All material exhibited must belong to the exhibitor.
- 2. Exhibits previously awarded NPS Grand, AAPE Silver, WE, or USSS within the last five shows must be materially changed to qualify for the same award.
- 3. All exhibits must be at the site between 2:00 and 6:00 p.m. Friday, March 17, and must remain until 4:00 p.m. Sunday.
- 4. Exhibitors must make their own arrangements for insurance.
- 5. Exhibits can be mailed (address inside); they will be returned promptly according to the exhibitor's instructions and provision.
- 6. An APS accredited judges will judge exhibits; their decisions are final. (Critique on Sunday at 1:00 p.m.)
- 7. Awards (listed inside) will be distributed Saturday at the critique, or mailed to mail-in exhibitors.
- 8. Frames fees: \$5 per 16-page frame (Ameripex style).
- 9. Exhibitors must furnish title page or one-page synopsis in advance.
- 10. Other questions decided by the Exhibition Committee.

AWARDS FOR EXHIBITS NASHVILLE STAMP SHOW 2023

In addition to medals representing the traditional five APS levels—gold, vermeil, silver, silver-bronze, bronze—the following will also be awarded:

- 1. NPS Gold, Vermeil, Silver, Silver Bronze and Bronze Ribbons
- 2. NPS Novice Awards (2nd, 3rd), for other first-time exhibitors.
- 3. NPS *Public Interest Awards* (1st, 2nd, 3rd) for favorite exhibit by public vote.
- 4. NPS Youth Awards (1st, 2nd, 3rd
- 5. APS Certificate of Award, for best exhibit by an APS member.
- 6. AAPE Award of Honor (2), for exhibits demonstrating excellence in presentation.
- 7. Kenneth Hinson Memorial Award, for best exhibit by member of the Nashville Philatelic Society.
- 8. American Topical Association Medal, for best topical exhibit.
- 9. American First Day Cover Society Certificate, for best FDC exhibit (if two or more FDC exhibits are entered.)
- 10. United States Stamp Society President's Award, for best exhibit of U.S. material (if at least a silver medal).
- 11. Women Exhibitors Sterling Achievement Award.
- 12. NPS Grand Award, for best exhibit in show.
